The Nature and Functions of Motives

** Make an Act Acceptable or Unacceptable to God **

An act performed, though it is good and conforms to acceptable standards, is not acceptable to God merely because of its performance. He judges the act on the basis of the motive. "Every act is judged by the motives that prompt it. Only that which is in accord with the principles of God's law will stand in the judgment." Motives reveal not only the goodness of good acts that are performed, but the evil of the evil acts. If the motive is impure, even though the act performed accomplishes some good and benefits humanity, still it is an impure act.
